Welcome to the Sixth International Congress and the Eighth National Congress of Wound and Tissue Healing. We are happy to announce the "6th International and 8th National Wound & Tissue Repair Congress" that will be held 1-4 February 2022, in Tehran, Iran.

Thanks for submitting your manuscripts at this congress; please read the notes carefully before submitting the article:

- This year congress will be held in the form of an online webinar due to the COVID-19 pandemic, for more safety and reducing the chain of virus transmission.
- The deadline for submission of papers in congress will be at January 21, 2022.
- Submitting articles to WTR Congress is possible only through the site of the congress, the section of Submission.
- Maximum two oral presentations and a maximum of two e-poster presentations by the same presenting author will be accepted for presentation at the virtual congress and will be published in the Congress book after being accepted.
- All abstracts will be reviewed by the Abstract Committee and the best article will be selected at the congress scientific board and published on this website.

- Who filling the form is known as the corresponding author of the article and the relevant certificate will be issued in her/his name. Therefore, you need to enter the corresponding author's information in order to complete the form.
- The names of co-authors of the articles are recorded in the Congress book. Therefore, it is necessary to pay attention to the correct insertion of the co-authors` information in English.

Manuscript Submission Guideline:

- All articles must be in English; all authors' information should also be included in English.

Research Articles (Original Articles)

- In the original articles, the Title page should include the complete title of the manuscript, the name of all the authors, the department or institution to which they are attached, address for correspondence with telephone numbers and e-mail.
- All original articles must accompany a structured abstract up to 250 words. It should be structured as Background, Methods, Results, and Conclusion followed by 3 to 5 Keywords. Keywords will assist indexers in cross-indexing the article as they are published with abstract. Use terms from the Medical Subject Headings (MeSH) list of Index Medicus (<http://www.nlm.nih.gov/mesh/MBrowser.html>).

Review Article

- In review articles, the Title page should include the complete title of the manuscript, the name of all the authors, the department or institution to which they are attached, address for correspondence with telephone numbers and e-mail.
- All review articles should be written in a non-structured form up to 250 words (one paragraph) and followed by 3 to 5 Keywords. Keywords will assist indexers in cross-indexing the article as they are published with abstract. Use terms from the Medical Subject Headings (MeSH) list of Index Medicus (<http://www.nlm.nih.gov/mesh/MBrowser.html>).
